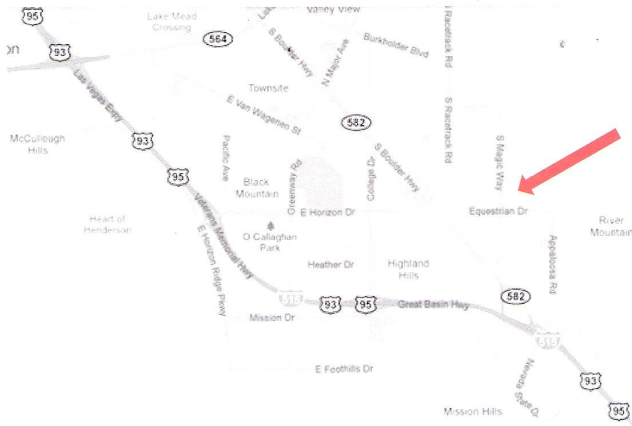
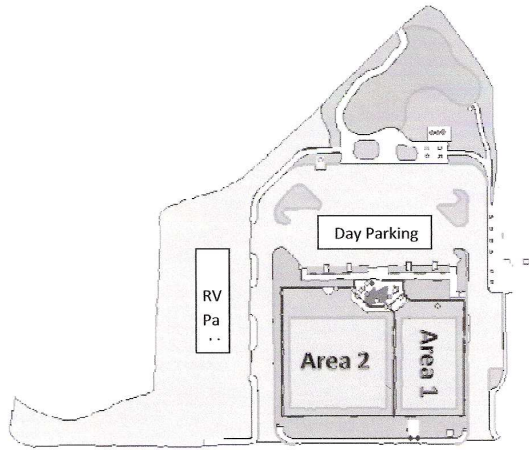

BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR (BBE) Class Eligibility

- 1) All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be **individual registered** with the AKC.
- 2) The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record & owner of record of the dog
- 3) To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL CLASSES) Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG CLASS - A Class for Dogs seven (7) years or older.
VETERAN BITCH CLASS - A Class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL CLASSES) Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dog and two (2) of their Get. It is not necessary that the get be under the same ownership as the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and require one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus additional class fee if the Stud is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The Class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRY FORM INFORMATION

1. Closing dates for the entries is 9:00 p.m., Wednesday September 21, 2011 at the SHOW SECRETARY'S address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted.
2. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telegraphed or telephoned entries cannot be accepted.
3. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms.
4. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee or because the dog is ineligible to complete due to incorrect entry.
5. Changes or additional information cannot be made by telephone. Such information must be received in writing or telegraphed prior to closing of entries as published in the premium list.
6. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club of Show Chairman.
7. Refunded checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club Treasurer will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent refunded checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
8. Refunds for cancellations prior to the closing will be made after the show.

10. Make all checks and money orders payable in U.S. currency to Cocker Spaniel Club of Las Vegas.
11. A recording fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC event service fee will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 20).

JUDGING

1. This show will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
2. There is no provision for un-entered dogs at this show.
3. Dogs must be ready for judging. No provisions are available for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judge need not wait for my dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
4. Dogs need be at the show only at scheduled judging time and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging.
5. This show is un-benched.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Set-up in designated areas only.
2. **NO ELECTRICAL AVAILABLE. You'll need to bring your own generators.**
3. **Tent stakes will not be allowed.**
4. All dogs must be held on leash or kept in crates except when being judged.
5. The CSCLV will not be held liable for any loss, damages or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
6. This show will be governed by the rules and regulations of the AKC. Exhibitors are advised to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the AKC referred to on the reverse side of the entry form that accompanies this Premium List.

RESERVED OVERNIGHT PARKING

Reservations are required.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
